### Blueberry Muffin Recipe

Section 14: King Arthur Flour Baking Contest Recipe: Blueberry Muffins Ingredients 2 ¼ cups King Arthur Unbleached All-Purpose Flour 1 ½ teaspoons baking powder ½ teaspoon baking soda ½ to ¾ teaspoon salt, to taste ¼ cup (4 tablespoons) unsalted butter, at room temperature ¾ cup to 7/8 cup granulated sugar, depending on tartness of berries 2 large eggs\* 2 teaspoons vanilla extract ½ cup

plain yogurt\* (full-fat will yield the most tender muffins) 1 ½ cups fresh blueberries\* \* Support Saratoga County Agriculture; consider purchasing eggs, blueberries and yogurt from local farms.

Directions Preheat the oven to 375 degrees F. Line a muffin pan with papers, and grease the papers. In a medium-sized bowl, whisk together the flour, baking powder, baking soda, and salt, then set aside. In a large bowl, beat the butter and sugar with a hand-held or stand mixer, until light, fluffy, and almost white in color. Add the eggs one at a time, beating well after each addition. Add the vanilla and yogurt, and mix until incorporated. Add the dry ingredients and mix on low speed just until the batter is smooth. Fold in the berries by hand. Scoop the batter into the prepared muffin cups, using a heaping ¼ cup for each. Bake the muffins for 18-24 minutes.

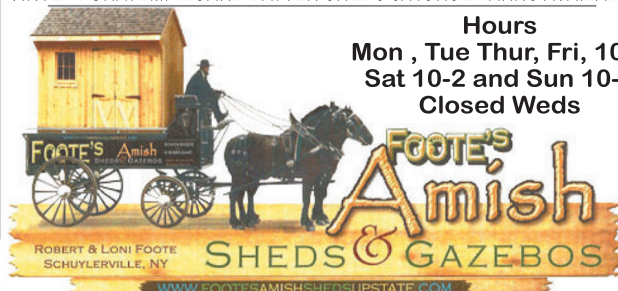
