





# 35th Regiment of Foot, 1757 Encampment at Roger's Island

The 35th Regiment of Foot is a living history reenactment unit that welcomes all those who wish to join the hobby. Unit members engage in the hobby of perpetuating our Country's history through demonstrations and historical encampments at local, state and National Historic Sites, Parks, and Museums.
